#### Chairman's Message

The year 2019-20 was eventful and for the first time the Trust has undertaken a completely different project which is a real need of the rural women. It is pity that even after 73 years of independence the menstrual hygiene of women is neglected badly which has resulted different diseases including cervical

cancer. The child birth has been affected seriously and may cause to disability to the new born babies. The social taboo connected with menstrual hygiene in rural areas and more particularly tribal areas affected the women very much. In the 21st century the use of sanitary napkin is still restricted to educated and town based women and the percentage is mere 52 % among the rural women of reproductive age. In addition to social stigma availability of low cost sanitary napkin is also a great problem.

To educate the rural women we have conducted a number of awareness camps involving SHGs and undertaken a project to produce low cost, bio-degradable sanitary napkin in joint venture with women group **PRERONA**. The project has multipronged effect (i) employment generation (ii) making awareness about menstrual hygiene among rural women, (iii) Minimize level of pollution as the products are bio-degradable. (iv)Improve the health condition of rural women. The project "AMAR SATHI" has started production and will continue to support the women.

Another unique project started during the year was "SEVA a centre for distribution of re-useable and new cloths". In the project people will visit our permanent centre and collect different cloths which includes Saree, Dhuti, Churidar, Pant & shirts, Lungee, Chadar, Rag etc. etc. The project has a huge success and I must acknowledge those have donated different items for the project. Unfortunately due to **PANDEMIC** the project is closed temporarily.

Another landmark achievement is Declaration of Blindness free village. Under the programmea village KISMAT KHEDYLE under Helan Vision Centre, Khanakul, Hooghly has been declared first "Blindness Free Village" in the district of Hooghly by BDO. The project was sponsored by OEU and financially supported by Cognizant Foundation.





Simultaneously a long cherished dream has also been materialized with financial support of Cognizant Foundation and active persuasion of Anup Zimba, Country Manager, OEU in March, 2020. We have one step advanced with the grant of Rs. 26.00 lakh sanctioned by Cognizant Foundation towards establishment of Retina Clinic.

A Sight First Conclave of all Lions eye Hospitals of the district 322 C 3 was organized in November 2019 attended by distinguished faculties includes Dr Biswarup Roy (H.O.D.Eye), Bankura Sanmilani Medical College, Dr. Suman Mukherjee, HOD (Eye), Malda Medical College, Dr AsimSil (Medical Director, VMNNN). Dr DivyeshP.Shah , Technical Adviser, Lions Club International MD 322, Dr Subijoy Sinha, Retina Specialist, Dr Anjan Mukherje, Microbiologist and Dr. Ekta Kapoor, Asst . Professor, RIO, Kolkata. The conclave was inaugurated by PID, Bishune Bajoria.

Another achievement towards computerization of system has been completed with installation of Integrated Hospital Management Software in our hospital sponsored by SEVA Foundation through mentee hospital VMANNN.

Before conclude I would like to acknowledge the support and contribution of the Lion Members, District Governor, Multiple District, esteemed Partners, Administration, State Health Dept., Panchayats, the patient & patient parties and all other stake holders . In fine I should not forget to acknowledge the contribution of the doctors and sincere work & support of the staff towards improvement of the activities of the hospital.

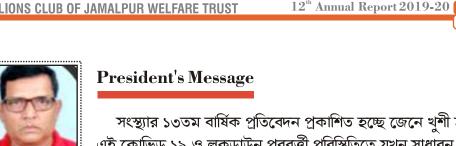

Dr Divyesh P. Shah, Technical Adviser, Lions Club International MD







322, Dr Subijoy Sinha , Retina Specialist, Dr Anjan Mukherje, Microbiologist and Dr. Ekta Kapoor, Asst. Professor, RIO, Kolkata were present and discuss on different matters connected with Eye Care for developing the patient care facility and managing the affairs in systemic manner. The conclave was inaugurated by PID, Bishnu Bajoria.



#### **Trainings**

With objective to establish an in-house training facility a team of three persons including Chairman attended a 5 days' workshop at LAICO, Madurai. The training cost was sponsored by OEU.

A team of 2 persons have been deputed to Sitapur Eye Hospital for attending "Machinery Maintenance" training sponsored by Vision 2020. Two



employees have attended a residential Counselor training at Neotia Eye Hospital, Kolkata sponsored by Auro Lab. A team of 2 persons have attended residential training for a week for developing and customization of IHMS software sponsored by SEVA Foundation at VMNNN, Chaitanypur. A young fellow deputed to LVPEI, Hyderabad for one year VT training sponsored by OEU.

### **Amar Sathi**

With an objective to improve the menstrual hygiene of the rural women a project AMAR SATHI has been conceptualized and implemented through the SHG



members. An all women group **PRERONA** has been formed for executing the programme. In the project the Trust and PRERONA jointly establish Sanitary





Napkin production unit and sale the same at low cost through the members of SHG and ASHA workers. The machinery has been installed in March, 2020 where bio-degradable sanitary napkin shall be produced by the SHG members. The project has simultaneously created livelihood opportunity of the SHG members.



#### SEVA a centre for distribution of re-useable and new cloths

The project has started in August, 2019 with objective to meet a part of the requirements of the poor and distressed people. In the project readymade garments ,shari , churidar, shirts, dhoti , lunge , bed sheet, shawl etc been collected from the members of the club and the well-wishers in good and re-

usable conditions. All collected stock have been washed, ironed and displayed in the permanent centre established for the purpose. People of a particular area invited to choose any one article and hand them over free of cost in a packet. More than 1500 articles distributed in the programme till March, 2020. The project temporarily closed due to PANDEMIC.



## **Temporary Projects**

A good number of temporary projects were undertaken during the year. The details are as under:



World Sight Day Observance: Observed World Sight Day on 10th October, 2019. A seminar was organized on Importance to fight against avoidable blindness. A free camp was organized where more than 100 people got the benefit of free treatment and patient identified with cataract provided with free surgical facilities

Women Empowerment project: Five workshop have been organized in association with PRERONA a women group to aware the members of different SHGs regarding the maintaining of menstrual hygiene vis-àvis need of use of Sanitary Napkin. The meeting was attended by SHG members and ASHA workers.

Sight for kids: 11thSight for Kids programme held at 6 different Schools. A total no. of 2251 students has been screened. Free Spectacles distributed to 72 nos students. Vitamin A deficiency identified with 17nos & 45 students referred to base hospital for treatment.





Observed 150th Birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi: Organized Free Health Check up Camp to obserbve the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. No of Banificiary-122, Neuropathy (Diabatic Foot) examination done -62, ECG-24.

World Diabetes Day: Observed World Diabetes Day and organised 3 Diabetes Screening camps (free) at Jamalpur Block Office, Local Railway Station and Main Bus Terminus respectively. Total people screened 822. B.D.O and Railway Station Manager attended the programme. The patients identified with Diabetic Retinopathy have been referred to our hospital where they have got free treatment facility.





**Annual Baby Show:** 6th Annual Baby Show was organized on 12th January, 2020 on the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda. A total number of 123 students have participated in the competition and successful candidates were rewarded. The energy of young parents with their babies gave a festive look in the programme.





#### Declaration of Avoidable Blindness Free Village Kishmat

Khedail: Under Avoidable Blindness Prevention programme of Operation Eyesight Universal a village Kismat Khedail under Helan Vision Ventrein Hooghly districthas been declared as "Avoidable Blindness Free Village" on 20 th December, 2019. The project covered an area of 29 villages having 50000 plus population started in August, 2017 was conceptualized by Operation Eyesight Universal & financially supported by Cognizant Foundation.





**Hygiene Kit Disatribution:** During the end of year PANDEMIC COVID 19 has stopped all normal functioning. However with financial help of OEU we have distributed 2100 Hygiene Kits among 2100 families covering 10500 plus populations. The programme has created awareness among the poor and distressed about safe hygiene to prevent spread of Corona virus.

Annual Sit & Draw Comp: A Sit & Draw competition was held on 23rd February, 2020. The programme was open. The response was very good. The programme was lively with active participation of students and parents in large number. A separate event was organized for the student of Lions Academy and they have been rewarded separately.



Hand over of Face Masks to OC, Jamalpur for use of police force: Dvery crisis has created an opportunity. Similarly we have explored the scope in the crisis by manufacturing sterilized face mask



engaging the SHG members. A total number of 25000 plus face masks have been produced within a period of one month and distributed 2000 face masks among the ASHA workers. Around 23000 sold at a subsidized rate to the ZillaParishad, PanchayatSamity, ICDS, Panchayats, Corporates local NGOs and directly to common people. During the period of distribution no such mask were available even to the Health staff. The programme has created an opportunity of earning of the SHG members.

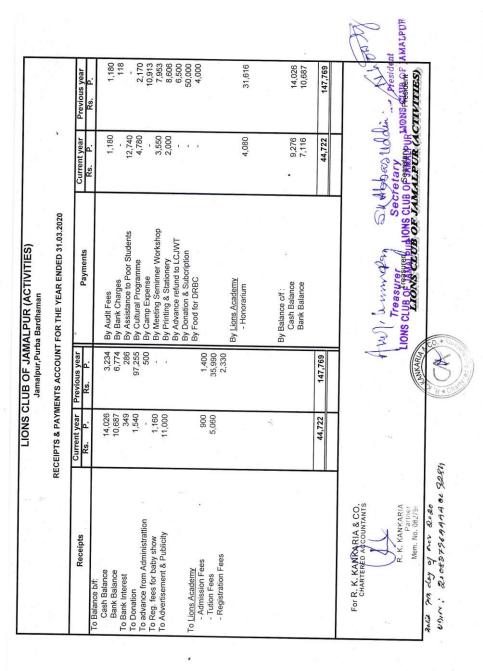
