### From Chairman's Desk

The year 2020-21 was a most challenging year in the history of the Trust. The year starts with national lockdown to prevent spread of COVID 19. The word Lockdown was not so popular among the common public and also the member of staff of the hospital. The hospital was closed for two and half months. The situation was getting worse due to

lack of knowledge and none in the globe is conversant with the protocol to handle the situation. The world economy was suffered a lot and the most affected area is health care. All are in the dark how to control the situation and extend service to the people. A series of advisory were published from different corners which are confusing and not possible to maintain. However the situation is settling down from September, 2021 till April, 2021 when 2nd wave of COVID 19 sets in. A new word "Social Distancing (Physical Distancing)" had become the talk of the people. All established rituals have come to a halt. People locked themselves in house, stop talking with neighbors and suspicious about other health condition.

However with tremendous effort it was possible to train and motivate the staff to perform their duty. Continuous online training and webinar was conducted to equip the staff to handle the situation. We are fortunate that with full cooperation of the staff and doctors we could overcome the situation. Even the full salary of the employees was paid within the year.

Every crisis has created opportunity. It was a fact in case of our hospital also. During COVID 19 situation our partner Operation Eyesight Universal sanctioned grant of Rs.7,24,840/- for spreading awareness and skill development training among the common people to prevent spread of COVID 19 through distribution of Hygiene Kit and IEC material. Under the programme 2150 Hygiene kits have been distributed among 10500 people in 51 villages of Hooghly and PurbaBardhaman districts. Another grant of INR 7,12,000/- sanctioned towards developing "Quality Eye Care and Beyond". SEVA Foundation has sanctioned INR 8,40,000/- for "Strengthening Hospital Eye Care Delivery Capacity".

The hospital has organized four COVID 19 vaccination camp with permission of District Health Department during July and August, 2021

and vaccinated 1125 people from different parts of the area.

Another achievement during the year was serving Corona virus infected patients by supplying oxygen cylinder at their doorstep. A total number of 10 (ten) cylinders were in circulation during the much needed period of 2nd wave. People from distant area like Pandua, Tarakeswar has also got the service. However with effort of all staff, doctors, and members of the club we are able to survive and overcome the crisis.

Another point we should mention that during the crisis period we have got maximum support under CSR scheme also. Cognizant foundation has sanctioned INR 26.00 lakh towards purchase cost of OCT instrument and establish Medical Retina unit.

In spite of all odds there was significant improvement in the service during the year. Two permanent projects have been added during the year. (i) Amar Sathi : A joint venture initiative of PRERONA and the Trust to manufacture bio-degradable sanitary napkin. Member of Self Help groups are working in the project and it is a great help for them to maintain their livelihood moderately with the help of the project. The crisis has not yet over and we should be careful and collectively fight against the spread of COVID 19. It is our firm belief that everything will be normal and people will feel relieved and social bonding shall be restored with god grace.

In fine I convey my sincere thanks to all the members of the club for their support. Staff is real assets of the organization. Without their support nothing is possible. I like to each and every staff for their dedication and self-less service. Doctor has diligently performing their duties and their role during COVID 19 was commendable. Salute to them for their sacrifice and dedication.

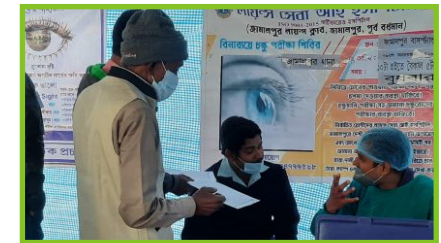

LSEH is the only dedicated eye hospital in the entire region covering 50 KM radius. The service area covering a population of 25lakh plus spreading over 12 revenue blocks of Purba Bardhaman ,Bankura & Hooghly districts. During the fy 20-21 we have conducted 52 no. of outreach camps.

### Seva Dental Clinic:

The clinic was established in the year 2014. Presently the clinic attended by the qualified Orthodontist having MDS degree. Different Orthodontist procedures and Pediatric dentistry are now available in the clinic. This is an only ortho dental clinic in the entire region. The facility is only available in the clinic at a very affordable cost.

The procedure includes: Complete dental examination, Fillings, Crown Procedure, RCT, Breeze, Anterior Root Canals, Dental X-ray, Complete Tooth restoration, Scaling etc.

The Clinic is very popular in the area. A good number of patients are regularly getting treatment facility from qualified and experienced Homeopathy Practitioner. The patient turnout is average 50 per day. People from all sections of society will get treatment at a very low cost.

### Grants & Assurances:

Operation Eye Sight Universal, Canada has sanctioned three Grants totaling an amount of INR 14,36,840/- under covid-19 Hygiene Awareness programme, Quality Eye care and Beyond Building capacities respectively. The Grants have helped us to improve a lot in different sphere of hospital activities. The number of Hygiene kit distributed was 2150 covering 10500 populations.

SEVA Foundation has sanctioned a grant for improving sanitization and also towards cost of PPE during COVID 19.
